## **Re: Freedom of Information Request**

Thank you for your request for information made under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 which was received into this office on 27<sup>th</sup> February 2017.

### **You Asked for:**

Since 01/01/2015, the number of patients awarded NHS Continuing Healthcare (NHS CHC) by the CCG relative to the number of patients that passed the Checklist and/or were referred for full assessment via the Decision Support Tool for NHS CHC.

### **Our Response:**

NHS Wirral Clinical Commissioning Group have had 326 CHC Eligible (non-fast track) patients from 587 Decision Support Tools, this equates to 56% eligibility.

Please note these figures are from January 2015 to December 2016.
