You Asked for:

The name of the current provider of your IAPT service,

NHS Wirral Clinical Commissioning Group's current IAPT service is provided by South Staffordshire and Shropshire NHS Foundation Trust – Inclusion Matters Wirral.

The date on which the current contract began,

The current contract began on the 1st July 2015.

The date on which the current contract is due to expire,

The current contract is due to expire on 30th June 2018.

The date on which the contract is due to be advertised for re-tender,

A date has not yet been set to advertise for re-tender.

The contracts estimated annual value at the last point that it was tendered,

The contracts estimated annual value at the last point tendered was £2,525,505.

Whether your current IAPT service contract is run as an AQP or block contract,

NHS Wirral Clinical Commissioning Group's current IAPT service contract is run as a block contract.

Whether your current IAPT service have been subject to any Performance Notices,

A performance notice has been issued in July 2016 relating to incident reporting and consultation relating to changes in delivery. This was responded to and subsequently closed.
