## Re: Freedom of Information Request

Thank you for your request for information made under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 which was received into this office on 02.02.2015.

### You Asked for:

I am requesting information relating to the scoring of competitive bids for the procurement of a Community Phlebotomy service in 2013/14 (see attached table).

I am requesting the \*full\* breakdown of bid scoring for the two bidders, as opposed to merely the overall score. This should show each bidder's scoring breakdown for each question/criterion, and should also show what each question/criterion was and how it was weighted. It should include the scoring of the financial side of the bids, without disclosing commercially confidential details of the pricing of each offer.

I have included the discussion of the section 43 exemption that I sent with my initial FOI request on this matter last summer, beneath my address; although since the bidders have been named the "alternative" option I set out in my original request no longer applies, the other points remain valid.

### Our Response:

Please find attached the questions that were completed by the two bidders for the Community Phlebotomy service and a spread sheet containing a full breakdown of the scoring for each bidder and question.
