

**Immediate prescription
required within the next 14
days?**

- **PRESCRIBE** the drug
- **DO NOT request the GP prescribes**

**New medication being
initiated in Secondary Care?**

- **The clinician who wishes to initiate medication for the patient should undertake appropriate pre-treatment assessment and counselling**
- They are responsible for communicating the rationale for treatment, including benefits, risks & alternatives, arranging any follow-up requirements that might be necessary, and documenting all of this in any related correspondence

**Ongoing prescribing from
GP required?**

- Please check the locally agreed Prescribing Formulary to ensure that the intended prescription is appropriate to prescribe, and potentially appropriate for continuation in Primary Care (RAG status)
- This is particularly important for any AMBER medications and those that require monitoring, for medications that are being used off-license and for any newer medications that may be unfamiliar to other clinicians
