Thank you for your request for information made under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, which was received into this office on 30th August 2019.

You Asked for:

- 1. The total number of Continuing Health Care (CHC) packages delivered in the individuals own homes (not care homes or residential facilities), that were managed in the financial year 18/19 (excluding any individual packages under £1,000 per week).
- 2. The total <u>value</u> of CHC spend in the financial year 18/19 and for this to be broken down to show spend with third-party providers (Non-NHS bodies)
- 3. Total number and value of emergency funded care (outside of CHC funded) packages.
- 4. Who is the main point of contact at the Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) responsible for commissioning CHC packages in the following areas:
 - Mental Health
 - Paediatrics
 - Adult
