In addition, NHS Wirral Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) successfully bid for funding for awareness training on Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) which is now being delivered jointly with the local authority. In total, 400 staff are expected to attend the 2 hour ACE awareness sessions over the next 2 years. A separate business case is being prepared with the local authority to train 16 people from a variety of organisations to deliver a 10 week adult programme and 8 week Children and Young People (CYP) programme for those people who have been affected by ACEs (ACEs Recovery Toolkit Training).
