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Re: Freedom of Information Request - Patients with Learning Disabilities recorded as Do Not Attempt Resuscitation (DNAR)

Thank you for your request for information made under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, which was received into this office on 8th January 2021.

You Asked for:

Under the Quality Improvement requirements for 2020/2021, GP practices are required to review their lists of patients with learning disabilities to identify those recorded as DNAR and then to confirm that this decision remains appropriate or to amend the patient's record.

For the GP practices within your Primary Care Network (PCN), please can you tell me how many patients with Learning Disabilities were recorded as DNAR, and how many patient records have been amended to remove this DNAR. If possible, please also give the age of each patient.
